At all the Masses last weekend we reflected on the Church's mission of Safeguarding and also celebrated a rite of atonement for all those who have been so gravely hurt by the sin and crime of sexual abuse in the Church. The Irish Episcopal Conference and the Association of Missionaries and Religious in Ireland fund and sponsor two organisations established to support those affected by clerical abuse: 'Towards Healing' which offers counselling, and 'Towards Peace' which offers spiritual direction.
