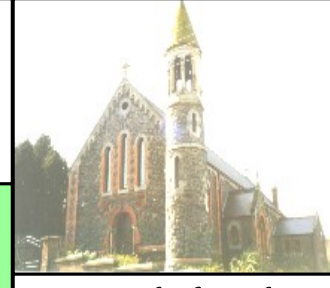

SUMMER MASS ROTA

As you have heard, due to the rapidly declining number of parishioners attending Sunday Mass and priests available for full-time ministry, our Diocese is to be divided up into 24 'Families of Parishes' in order to facilitate the more effective sharing of personnel and resources.

Our Parish will belong to the 'Family of Parishes' known as 'Belfast 16' which will also include Glengormley and the Loughshore Parishes (Greencastle, Whitehouse and Whiteabbey/ Greenisland). There are four priests in this family at the moment: Canon Aidan Kerr, Fr David Delargy, Fr Patrick Sheehan and myself. It is envisioned that in due course there will only be one priest in this 'Family', possibly assisted by a permanent deacon.

Before our new bishop, Dr Alan McGuckian, SJ, finalises the establishment of the 24 'Families of Parishes', the priests of the diocese have been encouraged by him and the 'Pathways to the Future' Steering-Group to work more closely together by way of creating a diocesan ethos of cooperation and solidarity. To this end the priests of 'Belfast 16' have come together to organise a shared Summer Mass Rota. This represents our first major joint project and sets the tone of how our parishes will collaborate in the future.

This summer rota will enable each priest to take a fortnight's holiday in July/August. In each parish a number of Sunday and weekday Masses will be suspended for the summer, to be resumed in September.

How will this affect our parish?

I will be on holiday 6th - 20th July and for the remainder of July and for the month of August I will be assisting in the other parishes of 'Belfast 16'.

During the month of July there will be no Sunday Mass in Whitehead – Sunday Mass resumes there on the 4th August.

There will be no Wednesday morning Mass in Whitehead on the 10th and 17th July – Wednesday morning Mass resumes there on 24th July.

There will be no Wednesday evening Mass in Carrickfergus on the 10th and 17th July - Wednesday evening Mass resumes there on 24th July.

As in previous years, there will be no Tuesday morning Mass in Carrickfergus in July and August – Tuesday morning Mass resumes there on the 3rd September.

Baptisms, funerals and sick-calls will be covered at all times by one of the four priests of our 'Family of Parishes'.

Let us support each other during this time of great change in our diocese.
